On Saturday, 10th September, Reskeon organised the Vittoria Dinner Dance at Firenze Receptions, Fawkner, which was well attended by more than 170 members and friends. Also with us was Past President of Reskeon, Mr George Scicluna and Mrs Anne Scicluna. An apology was received from Life Member of Reskeon Maltese Association Seniors Group Inc., Mr Caesar Vella and Mrs Phyllis Vella..

Music was in the hands of DJ King Charlie who catered for the music enjoyed by young and old and kept everyone on the dance floor all night.

This year we were pleased to see amongst us a lot of young ones who enjoyed the dinner dance and asked us to let them know for next year.

MC for the night was Mr Joe Cutajar. After he welcomed all those present and thanked President, Salvina Vella, who single-handedly organised the dinner dance, he invited everyone to be upstanding for the singing of the Maltese and Australian National Anthems.
