Well 2018 was a big year of indoor netball for Madison Conwell (Rosemary Sacco's granddaughter).

In May 2018 Madison represented Queensland in the Under 19 mixed indoor netball national competition. From these nationals she was selected to represent Australia in October 2018. Madison travelled over to South Africa representing Australia again in the Under 19 mixed indoor netball team. This was her Australian indoor netball mixed selection. She previously represented Australia in the Under 16s ladies competition in 2015.

Madison competed in the 6s New Zealand game where she came away with a silver medal. The Australian side going down to New Zealand in the grand final.

Madison also competed in the 7s Australian game where she came away with a gold medal. The Australian team were undefeated. Madison represented Australia very well all week and even overcame a severe gastro bug where she was hospitalised on grand final day. But this didn't stop her, Madison showed guts and determination and she still managed to play a quarter of the grand final. Her family and friends were extremely proud of the grit that she showed even though she was not feeling well.

At the end of October after returning from representing Australia, Madison again had to compete at the Zones competition representing the Gold Coast. From this competition she has been selected to represent Queensland in the top

Under 23 mixed indoor netball team for 2019. This is an extraordinary achievement as she was competing against players who are 2, 3 and 4 years older than her. She will now represent Queensland at Nationals to be held on the Gold Coast in May 2019.

To round up the year Madison was also voted Most Valuable Player (MVP) at club level for the Beenleigh Indoor Sports superleague Under 23 mixed team. This award was awarded to Madison from her efforts throughout the 2018 superleague season.


