Northern Federation of Ethnic Senior Citizens Clubs

We assume that not too many members of Reskeon Maltese Association Seniors Group know that our Group are members of the Northern Federation of Ethnic Senior Citizens Clubs.

Our President and Secretary, Salvina Vella and Paul Vella respectively, attend meetings of the Federation every month at Bell Motel, Bell Street, Preston.

The meetings start at 1.30 pm, so you can imagine the rush to go there after finishing the weekly meeting at Merrilands Community Centre. We have to leave and rush to get there on time but this is not always possible.

While at the meetings of the Federation, Salvina and Paul meet members of other clubs from different ethnic backgrounds such as Italians, Macedonians, Greek, Chinese, Vietnamese, Indian, Polish, Filipino and Mauritius.

We sit together and share our experiences with our clubs and learn from each other.

The meetings run for two hours. Sometimes we have speakers to discuss different topics.

The Northern Federation of Ethnic Senior Citizens Clubs was formed in 1998 to provide stronger voice and support for ethnic Senior Citizens Clubs in the Northern Region. This is more commonly known as Federation. Federation is an incorporated Association and is auspiced by Spectrum.

The Federation now represents many clubs in the Northern Region.

Some of the aims of the Federation are to provide an opportunity for representatives to meet together and identify common issues, to exchange information and share skills and where possible share resources. To promote awareness of relevant policies and programs impacting on the elderly. Represent the interests of member organisations to agencies, services and government departments. To provide feedback to service providers, agencies and government bodies on policies and program levels. To encourage agencies and services to be more culturally sensitive to senior citizens from diverse backgrounds. To work closely with peak bodies such as Ethnic Communities Council Victoria and Council of the Ageing and our auspicing body Spectrum, and to encourage membership from new and emerging groups of senior citizen groups.

We meet each month, every second Wednesday of the month. Reskeon pay an annual membership fee of \$10 to be members.

Salvina and Paul attend most of these meetings when time permits and as well the Annual General Meeting.


Lately we had a few changes in Co-Ordinators. The present Co-Ordinator is Ms Filomena Ciociola.


