Talk on Elder Abuse

On Wednesday, July 18, Ms Dorothy Campbell, visited our members to give us a talk on Elder Abuse.

Around 120 members were present.

The main points about elder abuse which Ms Campbell talked about were:

Elder Abuse is any act which causes harm to an older person and is carried out by

someone they know and trust such as family or friends.

Elder abuse includes emotional abuse, financial abuse, social abuse, neglect, physical abuse and sexual abuse.

It is estimated that 2 - 7% of older people (over 65) in the community suffer abuse.

There is a wide range of ways that older people may be abused.

And there is no one way of dealing with abuse. No 'one size fits all' solution.

Financial abuse is 40 - 50% of the work of Seniors Rights Victoria

Most often the abuse is by an adult son or daughter.

Seniors Rights Victoria provides a free, confidential support and help service for older people dealing with abuse.

Services include our helpline, free specialist legal services, short term support and advocacy and community education.

Interpreters will be provided if needed and there is no charge.

Our members stayed very attentive to this talk and Ms Campbell was please by them and the number attended.

The Group plans to have more talks of interest and of benefit to our memers.


