Work Development Permit Scheme

Do you have unpaid fines? The Work and Development Permit Scheme (WDP) provides a non-financial way for you to reduce or clear your unpaid fines while gaining new skills.

How it works:

- Join the WDP for FREE
- Enrol in a course or activity with Prace*
- Attend your course or activity at least once a month
- For every hour you study you will reduce your fine debt

Who is eligible?

To participate in the WDP scheme at Prace you must**:

- be experiencing acute financial hardship (includes being on a Centrelink payment)
- be the victim of family violence
- be experiencing homelessness
- · have an addiction to drugs, alcohol or a volatile substance, or
- have a mental or intellectual disability, disorder or illness.
